Autobiographical methodologies are an educational approach that uses the narration of one's own story or the collection of life stories, as an opportunity to activate learning processes, self-care, intercultural and intergenerational dialogue, active citizenship.

These methodologies can be used in the most diverse contexts of social and educational work: with young people and adults in non-formal education, to facilitate self-knowledge and bring out skills; with elderly people; with people with disabilities; in projects that work on the territories, to foster mutual knowledge among different cultures through life stories or to enhance the cultural identity of a territory.

The workshop aims to introduce educators, trainers, volunteers, social workers to the use of these methodologies.
