



ENHANCE CIVIC COMPETENCES THROUGH STORYTELLING

Erasmus Plus - KA1, Mobility of Youth Workers

Project Aims

The project comprises the construction of a course designed to train youth workers on the issue of how to develop civic and social skills, and active participation in social change, in young people.

The methodology that the project will use, and that participants will learn, is the collection of stories through autobiographical methodologies and multimedia (video interview, photo narration).

The idea is that, through the pleasure of collecting stories and create multimedia narrative, young people can learn many things like:

- to know the recent history, through the stories of those who participated in the battles for civil rights and democracy, namely those achievements that we often take for granted, but which have been decisive for the creation of democracy;
- to learn more about the current social, political and economic reality, that often appear too complex and boring for a young audience, but it can be better understood through concrete and real stories;
- to know the possible solutions that have been designed and sometimes implemented by people and organizations, especially civil society; stories that demonstrate that it is possible to create a change, and that can help young people not to give up dreaming, want a better world, and become their own agents of change.

Activity

Training of youth workers.

- Participants: 28 youth worker (no age limit).
- Duration: six days, plus two travel days.
- Period: : From 10th to 15th June 2019 (arrival on 9th – departure on 16th)
- Location: Rome

Training contents

The project comprises the construction of a training course for youth workers from different European countries, lasting a week

Course content will include:

- Civic skills and social education for young people;
- Introduction to the autobiographical methods;
- Methodologies of video interview and photo narration;
- How to engage young people in a project to collect stories on the theme of social change;
- European instruments of certification.



As a whole the project includes several phases, for a period of about one year:

- Start-up phase;
- Realization of the course;
- Evaluation phase.

Financial rules

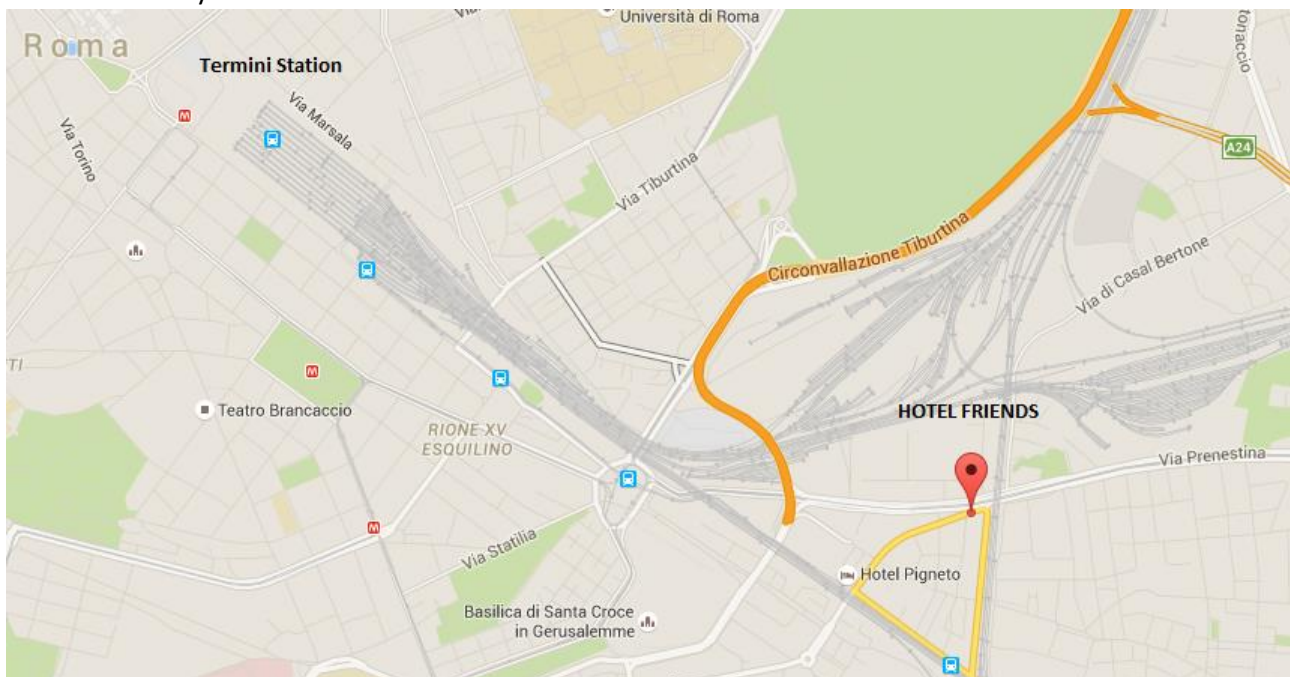

To reach Amico Hotel from Termini railway station take the tram n.5 or n.14 (20 minutes) and get off to the stop Piazzale Prenestino. The hotel is directly in front of this stop on the left side. Or take bus n. 50 for 9 stops to Piazzale Prenestino

- **BIT - INTEGRATED TIME TICKET** (€ 1,50)

Valid for 100 minutes from first validation; you can take with the same ticket all the bus, tram, train (urban route) and the Metro (but the metro just once), within 100 minutes.
